Australia's oldest Italian building has a "Pot pourri" of fun and entertainment at next weekend's ChillOut Festival.

To kick things off the Lucini's Supper Club will launch on the Friday from 8.30pm with live music. Maria Viola will put on a tasty Italian supper for guests just arriving into town or wanting to stay on after dinner. Special guest for the night is roving musician "Filippo" who performs in 15 languages to sing-along with. Lucini's recently finished bar will feature some 'Chillout' cocktails, good local wines, boutique beers and some Italian favourites!

On Saturday, garden Bocce and lunch hosted by Arcilesbica Australia starts from 12 noon with a gold coin donation towards ChillOut Better Buddies. The Old Macaroni Factory's bocce court was created in 2003 for the filming of "Loves Brother".

On Saturday night a themed dinner features talented musicians Phil Carroll and Grisca Cveigoren who'll perform as "Ame Roma" (*we are gypsy*). They'll play and sing lively and memorable gypsy, jazz and European music, which should get the factory glowing! Phil is an accomplished pianist and piano accordionist and has just returned from 3 months playing in Istanbul. He has formed various groups from jazz to latin and world music and played across the country and overseas. Grisca graduated in violin from the Latvian Conservatorium of Music and moved to Australia in 1992. He has toured across Europe in gypsy ensembles. The Saturday night show and set menu at \$60 per head, includes delicious antipasto platters, fresh pastas, dessert of Gelati or Italian Apple Cake - plus coffee and cholates and a glass of Lambrusco.
